

Tying Ideas

*Each day can be different or you can find the look that suits you and stick to it.
Its your choice, but please have fun doing it.*

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Basic Tying Instructions



Hold the scarf in your left hand with the back spread out at the loop.



Pull the right-hand ribbon and possibly the left ribbon through the loop.



Cross the ribbons or pull the other ribbon through the loop.



Tie one or two knots. The scarf is now tied. The ribbons are now fastened.



If less volume is required in the scarf, push the material down along the ribbons on both sides and at the back.

If more volume is required in the scarf, pull the material up along the ribbons on both sides and at the back.

The scarf can now be removed and put on again without having to retie it.



Long Ribbon Scarf

Basic Turban Style Tying Instruction



Place the scarf on the head and let the ribbons hang down the back.



Take one ribbon in each hand and cross them at the back. It is important to tighten the ribbons so that the scarf fits tightly over the forehead. You may chose to use a knot at the base of your head to secure this.



Lead the ribbons up along each side of the head.



Cross the ribbons on the forehead and lead the ribbons down along each side of the head.



Gather the ribbons at the back and tie one or two knots. The scarf is now tied and ready to use.



If less volume is required in the scarf, push the material down along the ribbons on both sides of the head and at the back.

If more volume is required in the scarf, pull the material up along the ribbons on both sides of the head and at the back.



Long Ribbon Scarf

Basic side Instruction



Place the scarf on the head and let the ribbons hang down the back.



Take one ribbon in each hand and cross them at the back. It is important to tighten the ribbons so that the scarf fits tightly over the forehead. This may be easier with a single knot at the back of the head.



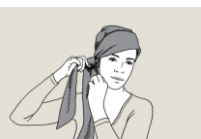
Lead one ribbon up along one side of the head and continue across the forehead.



Make sure to tighten the ribbon over the forehead. Stop just behind the ear.



Tie one or two knots behind the ear.



Lead the longer ribbon "flatly" round the knot.
Lead the ribbon "flatly" round the knot 3-4 times until both ribbons are of the same length.



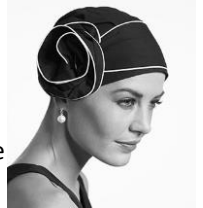
Now pull the ribbon between the knot and the layers round the knot. Tighten.



The scarf is now tied and ready to use.

Long Ribbon Scarf

Difficult Rose Instruction



Place the scarf on the head and let the ribbons hang down the back.



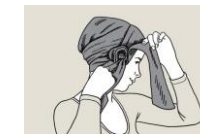
Take one ribbon in each hand and cross them at the back. It is important to tighten the ribbons so that the scarf fits tightly over the forehead. This may be easier with a single knot at the back of the head.



Lead one ribbon up along one side of the head and continue across the forehead, making sure to tighten the ribbon over the forehead. Stop just behind the ear.



Tie one or two knots at the ear. Tighten the knot.



Lead the longer ribbon edgeways round the knot until just approximately 5 cm of the ribbon is left.



Fasten the ribbon by slipping the end under itself (the one placed round the head) behind the knot and out through the fastened layers.



Now pull the end completely out through the layers and tighten.



Lead the shorter ribbon edgeways round the layers until approximately 5 cm remain. Fasten the ribbon by slipping the end under itself (the one placed round the head) behind the knot and out through the fastened layers.



Tighten. The rose is now tied.
The outer layers may be fastened using one or two safety pins.

Other Tying ideas.

Cross Over Turban Style

When you get to point 4 of the **Basic Turban** Tying Instructions. (Cross the ribbons on the forehead and lead the ribbons down along each side of the head.)

Stop at the front of your head and rap the two ribbons around each other once.

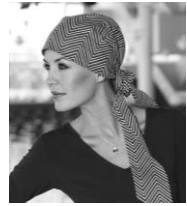
Take the ribbon back down the side it came from.

Continue the rest of the Basic Turban Tying Instructions.



Simple Knot

Just tie the ribbons in a large loose knot at the back of your head.



Use the **Crinkled Ribbon effect** with any of these tying methods and you get another variety of looks.

The Crinkle Ribbon effect. (Like shown on scarf 8200-233)

Washing instructions - To retain the optimum crinkle effect on the ribbons



Rolled Ribbon Turban look.

After Point 1 of the **Basic Turban** tying instructions. (Place the scarf on the head and let the ribbons hang down the back.)

Tie a knot at the base of your head.

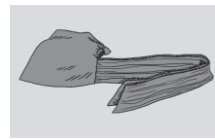
Grab each ribbon and twist it. Twist it a lot for a more rased look.

Then continue with the rest of the Basic Turban Tying Instructions.

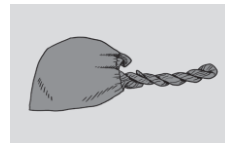
You can also do the **basic cross over** and **rolled Ribbon Turban** together for another great look.

Rasied Turban look

Why not do the **Basic Turban** look but when you rap it around your head don't do it completely at the front of the scarf. Do it a little further back.



Carefully wash the scarf following the washing instructions on the label.



Twist the ribbons tight, while wet.



Let the scarf dry flat.



Your Own Ideas



Side Bow Style

After point 5 of the **Basic Side Instructions** (Tie one or two knots behind the ear.) stop following the Basic Side Instructions and begin following these instructions.

With the second knot tie a bow. As you would with your shoelace.

Another way of doing this is very similar to the knot style, but instead of wrapping the long end around the knot twice, tightly, try doing the second one very loosely.

Then adjust the bow to suit the length you might want.

Try doing the side bow with the **rolled ribbon turban**. It looks great.
